## **Call for Papers:**

The *Derrida Today* Conference will focus on the ongoing value of either Derrida's work, or deconstruction, to the political-ethical, cultural, artistic, public debates and philosophical futures that confront us. The conference is interdisciplinary and invites contributions from a range of academic, disciplinary and cultural contexts. Papers and panel proposals from academics, independent scholars, and graduate students are welcomed. The conference encourages contributions on diverse topics and contemporary issues, and from any discipline in relation to Derrida's work and deconstruction.

Individual papers: each paper will be 20 mins, with 10 mins for Q&A Panels: will run from 90 mins (with 3 papers), or 120 mins (with 4 papers).

## \*SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS\*

**Individual Participants**: in one Word document provide: **1)** a 350 word abstract **and** title for a 20 minute paper, **2)** a personal bio (200 words max.), **3)** university affiliation and contact details including: mailing address (to send journal issues), email address, and mobile or contact phone number.

**Panel Proposals:** Panels will consist of 3 or 4 papers of 20 minutes delivery and 10 minutes discussion time each. Panel organizers should submit a Word document, with the following details: **1)** an overall panel proposal of 350 words **2)** 3-4 individual abstracts of no more than 350 words for each paper, **3)** personal bios (200 words max) and contact details of <u>each</u> member: phone, email, affiliation, mailing address.

**Due Date for Abstracts and Panel Proposals**: Open Sept 2025 and close 30 Dec 2025.
